- Continually strive to improve health and safety performance by establishing clear and measurable targets and objectives, auditing, reviewing, monitoring and reporting performance.
- Support the safe and early return to work, where appropriate, of Workers.
- Meet all obligations under the Health and Safety at Work Act 2015, the applicable regulations, codes of practices and any relevant standards or guideline.

WORKERS, CONTRACTORS and VISITORS:

- Are required to adopt safe work practices and comply with all health and safety policies and procedures and to report safety hazards or unsafe work practices.
- Have responsibility and authority to stop work if there is any question related to safety or operational risk.
